The Board recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The proposed agenda was reviewed. A motion was made by Manager Kutter to approve the agenda with additions. Manager Kuseske seconded it. The motion passed with all in favor.

The Board tabled the minutes of the May 6th meeting.

Manager Robinson made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report comprised of checks #17447-17487. Manager Kutter seconded it. The motion passed with all in favor.

Don Lieser and Dave Bailey attended the meeting to discussion a possible cleanout of County Ditch 9. Interim Administrator Arceneau suggested that Managers Kuseske and Mostad complete an inspection and bring an inspection report back at the next regular meeting.

The Activity Report was reviewed. There was discussion on whether or not the Weed Harvest Equipment could be used on other lakes. After considerable discussion, Manager Mostad made a motion to have the Weed Harvest Equipment remain solely on Sauk Lake. Manager Kutter seconded it. The motion passed with all in favor.
