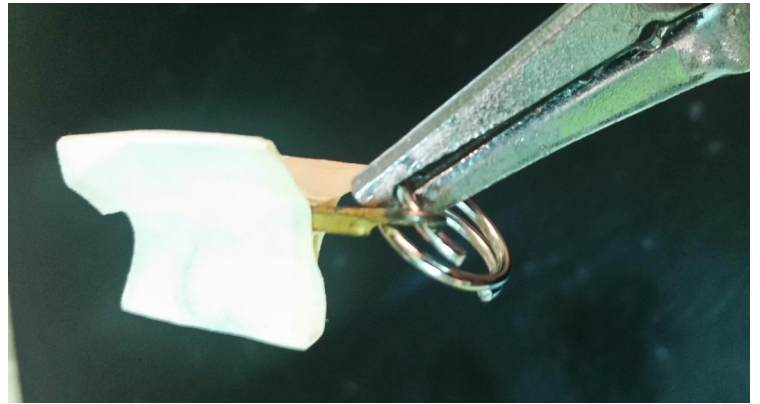


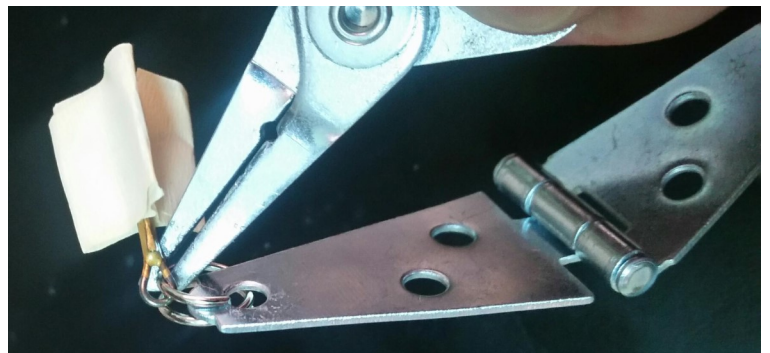
# Make Your Own Fishing Lure (Daredevil)

**Step 1.** Using the pliers, open the bigger split ring and thread the split ring through the hook eyelet until it moves freely.

(Like putting a key on a keyring).



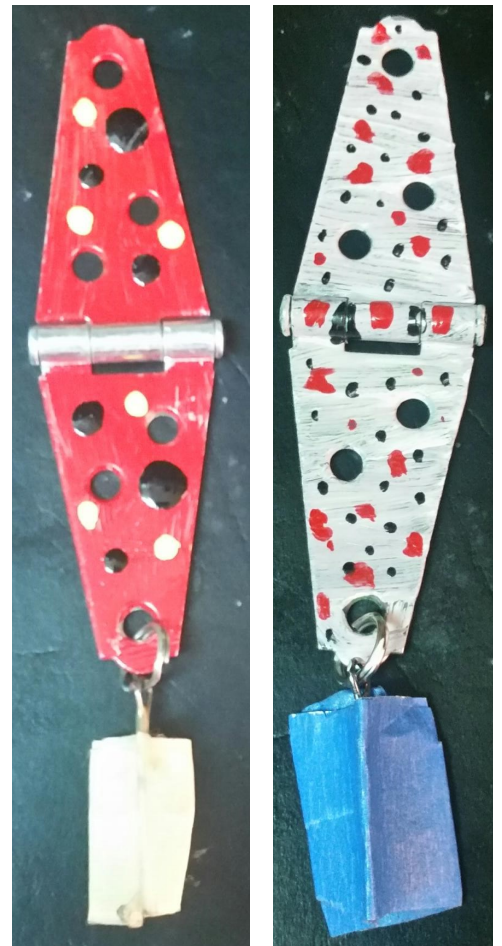
**Step 2.** Using the pliers, open the split ring again and thread the split ring (with hook) on to the end hole of the hinge until it moves freely again.



**Step 3.** Paint the lure any combination of colors you want. Be careful until it dries, the paint is oil based and will stain your fingers and clothes. If you want to paint both sides, fold it slightly and it will stand on the side. Use an envelope to transport your lure home if it is not completely dry. Let it dry overnight before using.



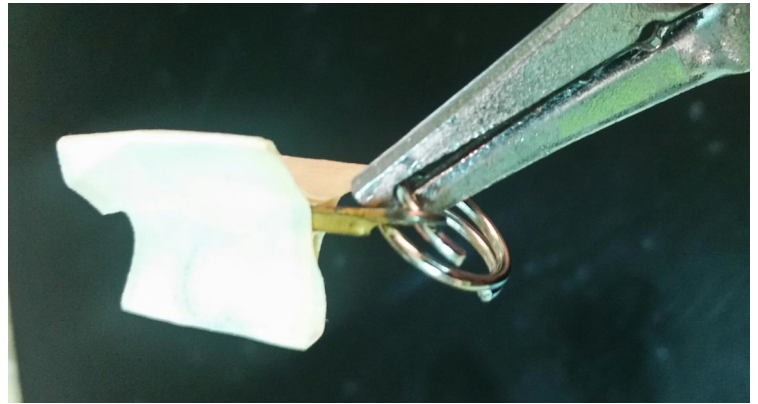
**Step 4. CATCH FISH!**



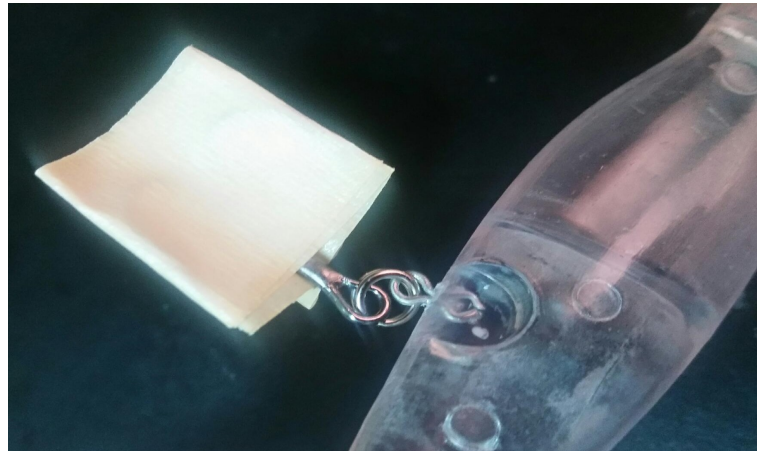
# Make Your Own Fishing Lure (Rapala)

**Step 1.** Using the pliers, open the smaller split ring and thread the split ring through the hook eyelet until it moves freely. Do this for two hooks.

(Like putting a key on a keyring).



**Step 2.** Using the pliers, open the split ring again and thread the split ring (with hook) on to the belly loop of the lure. Repeat using the second hook for the tail loop of the lure.



**Step 3.** Paint the lure any combination of colors you want. Be careful until it dries, the paint is oil based and will stain your fingers and clothes. Use an envelope to transport your lure home if it is not completely dry. Let it dry overnight before using.
