### Notes from Meeting:

Julie presented the implementation tables that had been sent out to the group. There is a table for watershed wide activities, as well as a table for each Water Management District (WMD). Within the tables specific water quality projects are identified, along with any specific location information that was provided. These tables are a compilation of data gathered from partners at the November meeting. The Advisory Committee will be reviewing these tables and submitting any recommended changes – additions, deletions, etc. with as much detail as possible.
