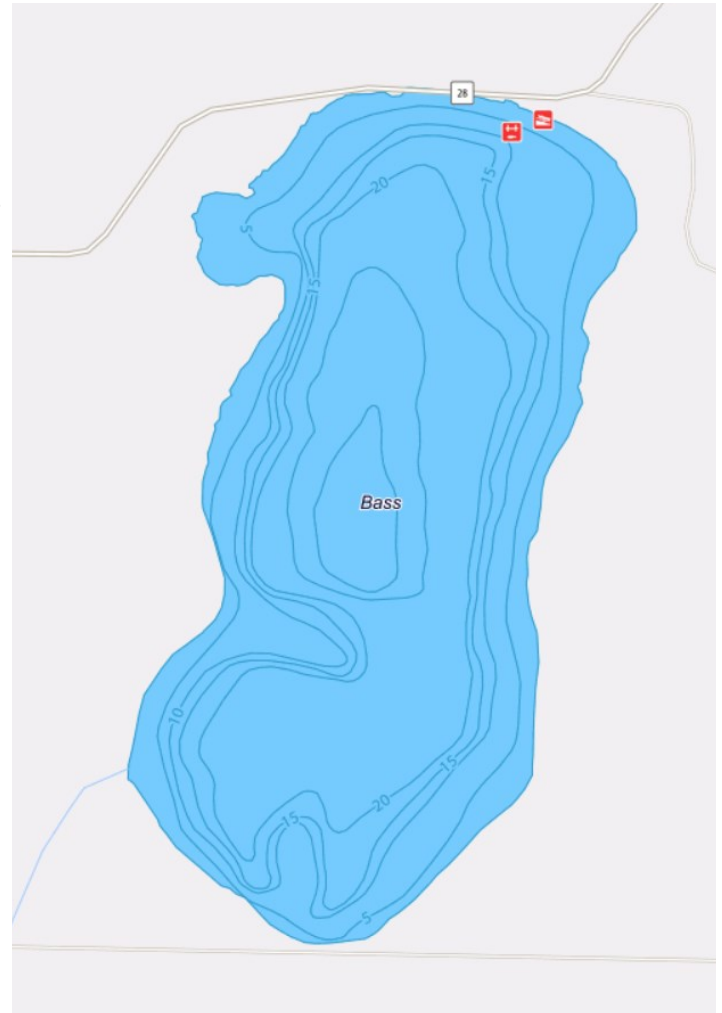


Bass Lake (Todd County)

OVERVIEW

Bass Lake is a relatively small, clear-water bass-panfish lake in Todd County. The lake lies on the outskirts of the City of Grey Eagle and provides a multitude of recreational opportunities for the area. The City maintains a park on the north end of the lake, which offers a fishing pier, swimming beach, picnic area, and boat access. The lake has some of the best water clarity in the area with a secchi disk reading of over 18 feet at the end of June. Weed lines, woody debris, and sunken points are the main fishing structures in the lake. Bass Lake has little development close to the lake, which probably benefitted the water quality.
