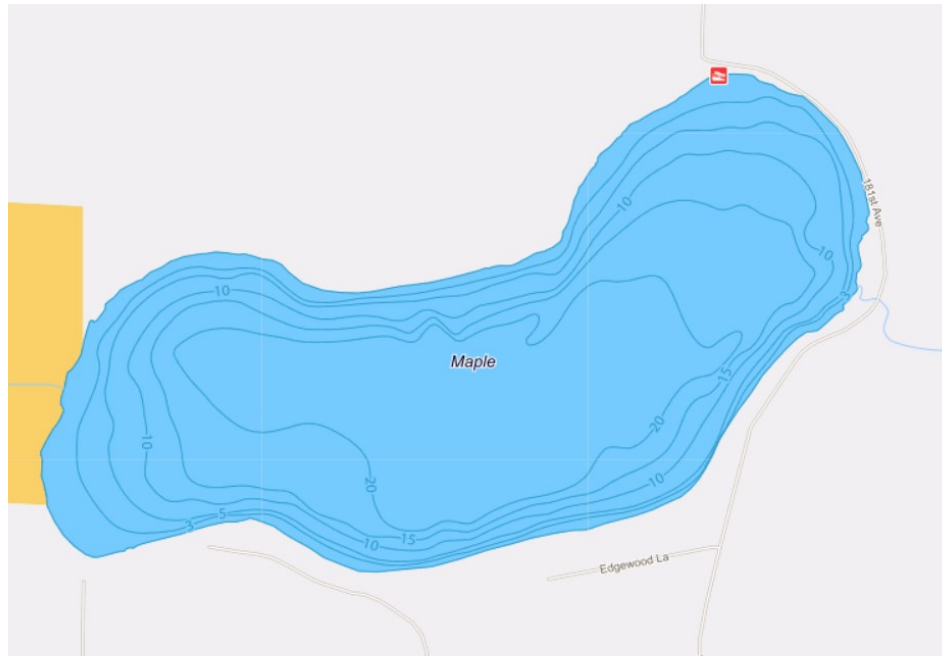


# Maple (Todd County)

## OVERVIEW

Maple Lake is a 388 acre lake located three miles southwest of Gutches Grove in Todd County. The lake has a maximum depth of 23 feet and a has small watershed dominated by row crops and pasture. A public access is located on the northeast end of the lake. Anglers can expect good fishing for Largemouth Bass, Northern Pike and Panfish. Maple Lake is a productive, nutrient-rich lake and has



moderate to heavy algal blooms throughout the summer. Maple Lake also has a diverse and robust aquatic plant community that provides substantial habitat throughout the whole lake. Cattails ring the north and west side of the lake and protect the shoreline from erosion and wave action.

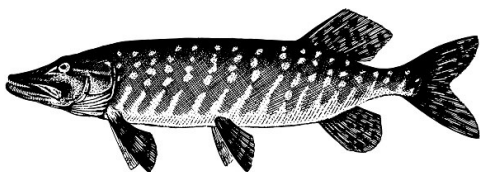
