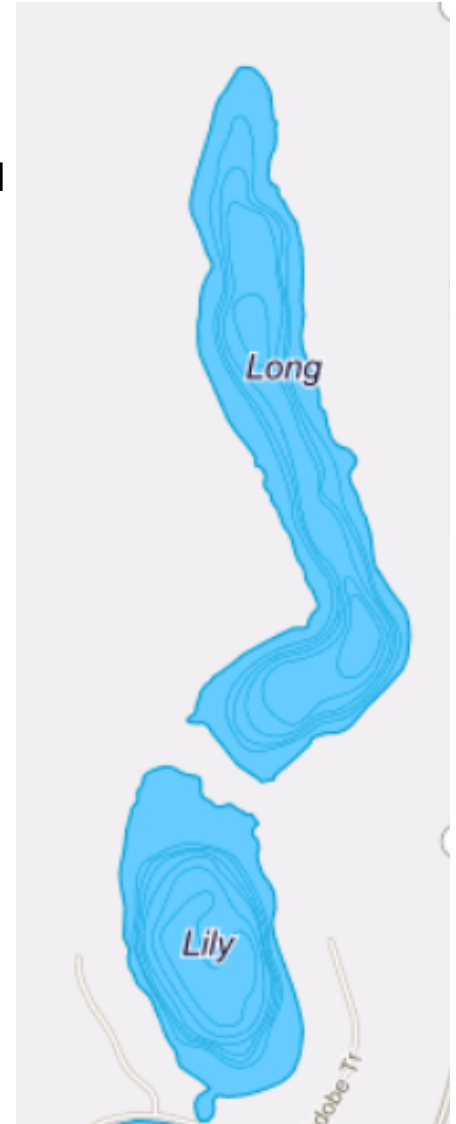


# Long Lake (Todd County)

## OVERVIEW

Long Lake is a 104 acre lake located near Little Sauk, Minnesota. Long Lake can be accessed through a channel from Lily Lake. DNR has classified Minnesota's lakes into 43 different classes based on physical, chemical and other characteristics. Long Lake is in Lake Class 34; lakes in this class are generally have a high amount of water less than 15 feet deep, turbid, and are a very irregular shape. People can have significant impacts on lakes and the fish populations they support. Harvest, lakeshore development, removal of shoreline vegetation, and introductions of invasive species can all adversely affect fish populations. Curly Leaf Pondweed has been identified in Long Lake. AIS are moved from infested to non-infested waters by anglers, boaters, and lake shore owners and can adversely impact lakes and fish populations.
