

Grand (Stearns County)

OVERVIEW

Grand Lake is a 650 acre lake located two miles south of Rockville in eastern Stearns County. It has a maximum depth of 34 feet and a modest watershed dominated by row crops, forest and pasture. A DNR public access is located on the south side of the lake. Grand Lake is primarily managed for Northern Pike and Walleye.

Emergent and floating leaf vegetation was common along the south and west shoreline, primarily wild rice, yellow waterlily and bulrush. Submerged vegetation was not surveyed, but coontail and chara were the dominant species. Curly leaf pondweed was present but rare. Water clarity was good; Secchi depth was 5.5 feet in August and MPCA data show an average of six feet over the last ten years. Dissolved oxygen was adequate to support fish down to 20 feet in mid July.

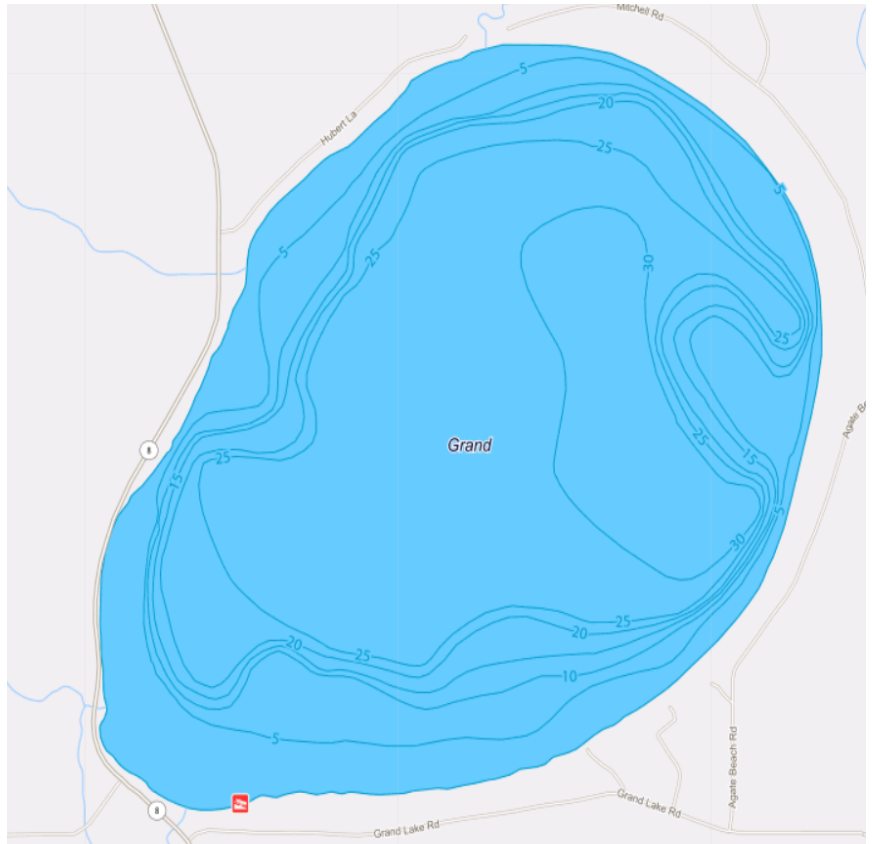
