

Pleasant (Stearns County)

OVERVIEW

Pleasant Lake is a small (219 acre) lake located three miles southwest of St. Cloud in Stearns County. It has a maximum depth of 33 feet and good water clarity averaging about 10 feet during the summer, which is relatively high for the area. A public access is located on the northeast side of the lake with space available for twelve trucks and trailers. Emergent and floating-leaf vegetation and emergent vegetation covered about 13% of the lake area and 45% of the shoreline. The most commonly found species were cattail, yellow waterlily, and bulrush. A point intercept aquatic plant survey was also completed.

Twenty-one species were identified and found growing to a maximum depth of 20 feet. The most common species found were coontail, chara, flatstem pondweed, and northern milfoil.

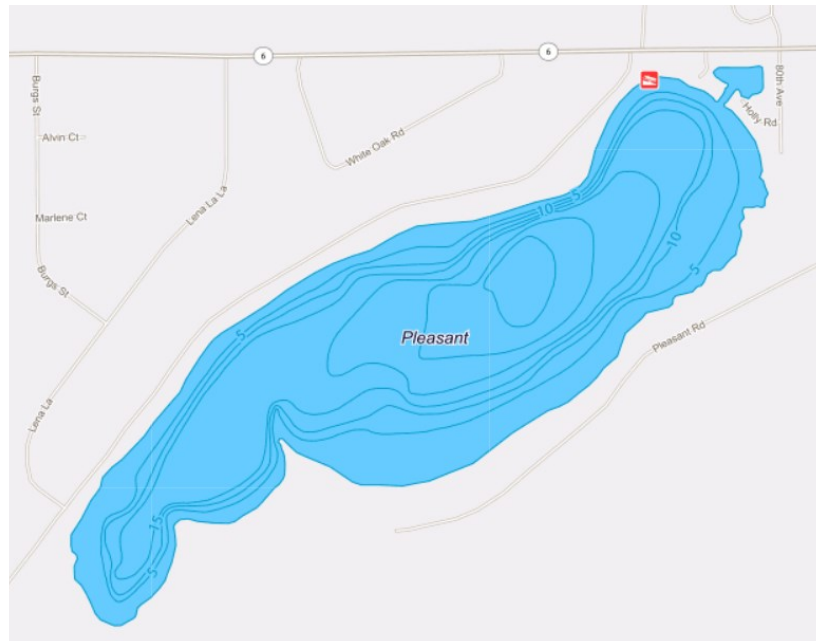
