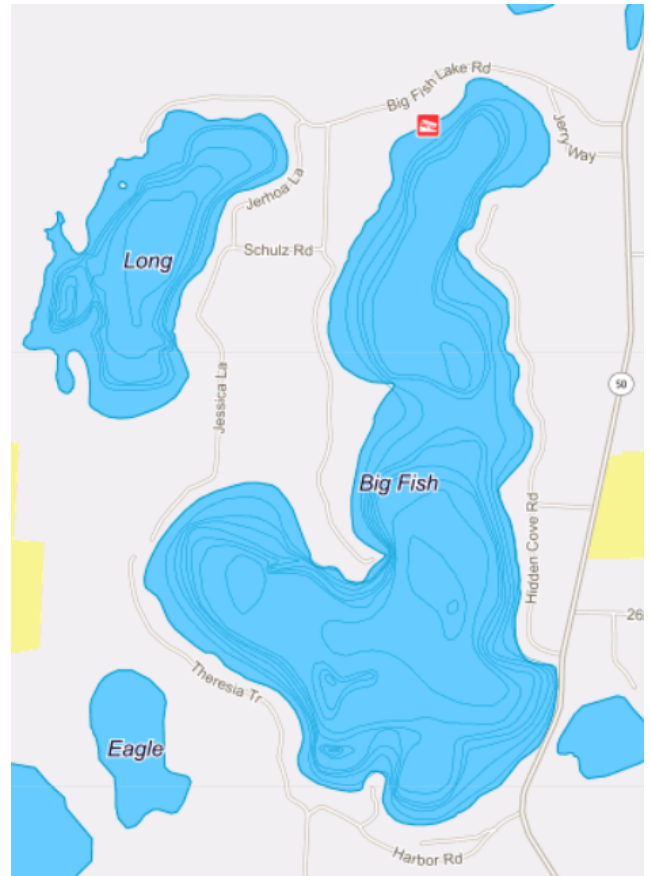


Long - Big Fish (Stearns County)

OVERVIEW

Long Lake is a recreational lake located near the town of Cold Spring in Stearns County. Land use in the Long Lake watershed was primarily forest and agricultural. No public access is available, but a large resort maintains a private boat access. The maximum depth of Long Lake was 46 feet and approximately half of the lake was less than 15 feet deep. Dissolved oxygen was sufficient to 19 feet. Water clarity was the highest recorded at 11 feet. Rooted aquatic plants were present to a depth of 19 feet. The lake was home to many kinds of aquatic plants including muskgrass, cattail, northern milfoil and three kinds of pondweed
