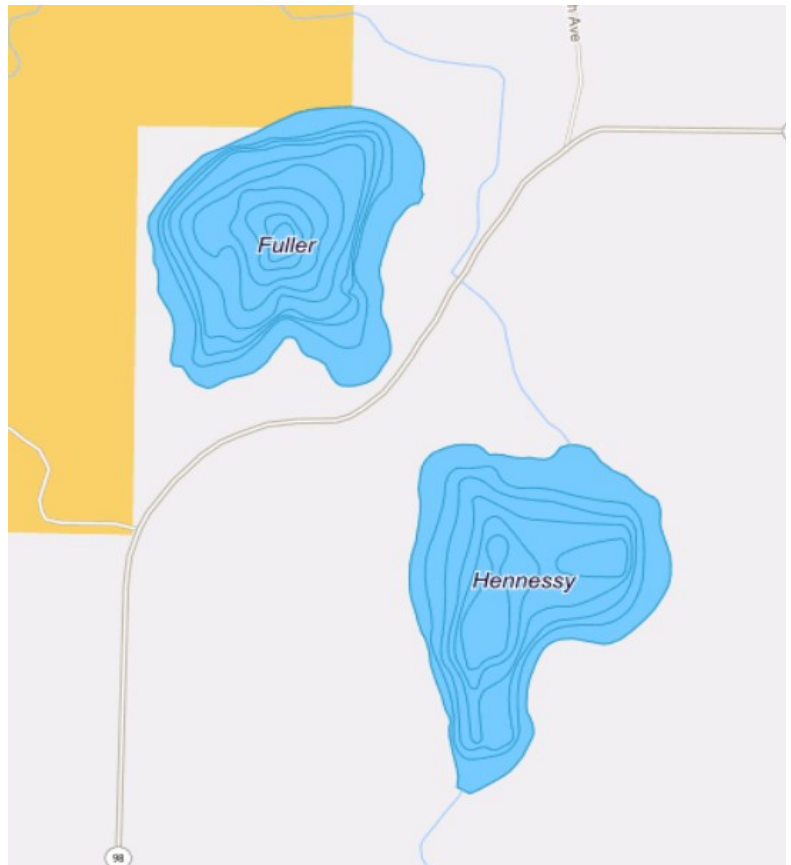


Hennessy (Todd County)

OVERVIEW

Hennessy Lake is a small, riverine lake in the Prairie Brook system with light development around its shoreline. Access can be gained off the county road upstream of the lake. Water levels can dictate the ease of access, too high and a boat cannot get under the bridge and too low the stream will be difficult to navigate. Water clarity at time of survey was fair with a secchi disk reading of 4.5 feet. Despite its small size, Hennessy has a diverse fish community which could be influenced by migration via Prairie Brook. Direct influence from Prairie Brook and the prevalence of agricultural in the lakeshed has impacted water quality in Hennessy making it more fertile and turbid than Fuller Lake.
