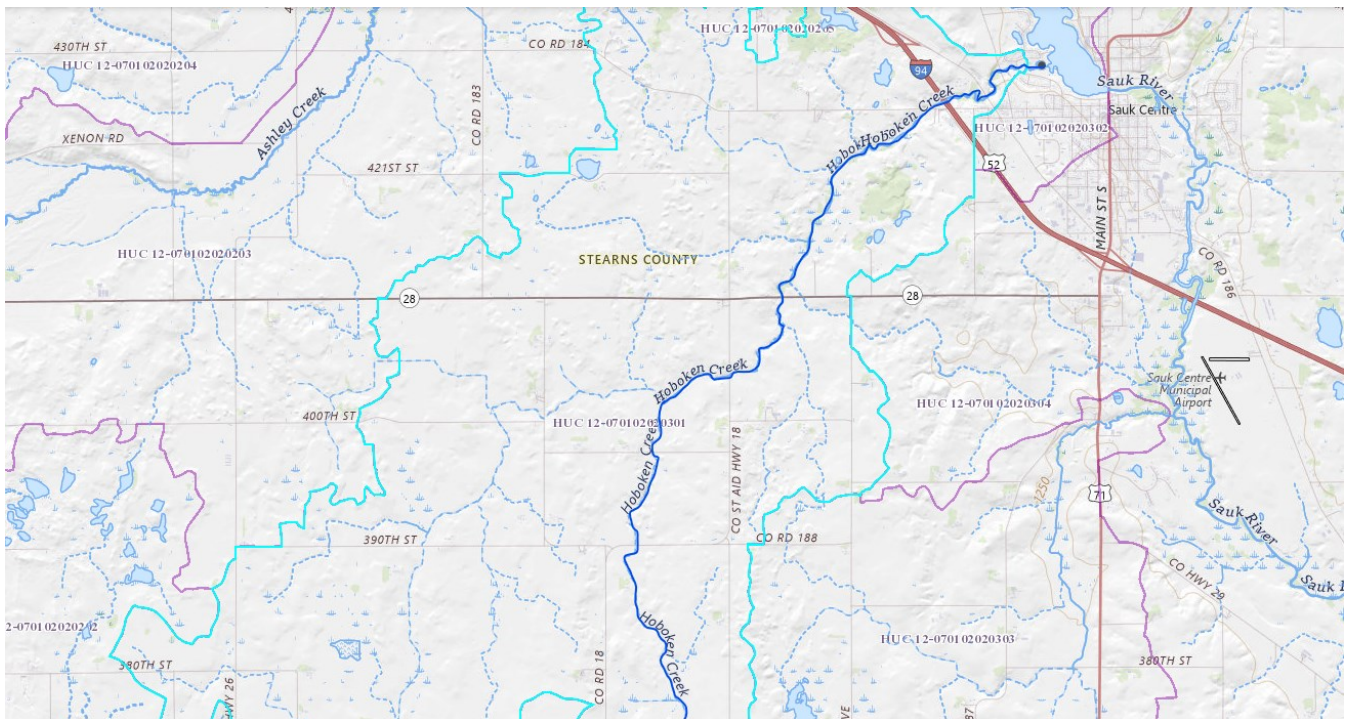


Hoboken Creek

OVERVIEW

Hoboken Creek is a warmwater stream in north-western Stearns County. With the headwaters beginning south of Sauk Centre, this stream flows north for almost 11 miles, eventually outletting into Sauk Lake on the east side of Sauk Centre. Hoboken flows underneath I-94, the Lake Wobegon Trail, then Fairy Lake Road (Cty Rd 17) in its northern reaches. One of the public ditches managed by the SRWD Drainage Authority, County Ditch #51, outlets into the stream. Hoboken has been assessed for aquatic life and is listed as impaired for fish bioassessments, but received a Fair rating (32) for invertebrate IBI.

The SRWD does actively monitor Hoboken Creek for water quality and quantity (flow) data, and has been since 2001. In 2023, the average phosphorus concentration was above the water quality (WQ) standard of 100 µg/L, but the average total suspended solids for the year was under the WQ standard of 30 µg/L .
