Review of previous meeting minutes:

- Becky Schlorf, Stearns County, provided a fiscal report/update, detailing expenses and encumbrances from each of the 11 WBIF Grant Objectives.
- Fiscal Agent Report approved upon motion by Manager Becker, Second by Commissioner Neumann.

Appointment of New Officers

FY2022-2023 WBIF Supplemental Funds Workplan

SRW Collaborative Cost-Share Policy -Technical Engineering Assistance (TEA) language addition

 - "For projects where TEA exceeds 20%, the LGU may request reimbursement for this overage through the Implementation Team provided there are TEA funds unencumbered in the WBIF. The Implementation Team will consider these requests on a case by case basis."

Education and Outreach Committee

- Motion by Manager Becker, second by Supervisor Uphoff, to formally establish the Education and Outreach (E&O) Committee. The E&O Committee will be provided one seat on the Implementation Team. E&O Committee is authorized to use the recommended procedures in the interim until the policy language is adopted at the May 2024 PC meeting.

Mississippi River-St Cloud Partnership & Sauk River Watershed Collaborative Boundary Alignment

- Motion by Supervisor Uphoff, Second by Supervisor Reents the SRWC Policy Committee
 recommends the following: The Sauk River Watershed Collaborative (SRWC) Policy Committee
 not seek a boundary adjustment for the Sauk River CWMP from the existing Sauk River HUC 8
 boundary and direct the Plan Coordinator to communicate this to the MRSC Policy Committee.
