

Christopher Kurilla WMA

OVERVIEW

The Christopher Kurilla Wildlife Management Area (WMA) features a rolling prairie pothole landscape with intermittent pockets of oak hardwood growing among wetlands and restored prairie. The WMA is adjacent to the Sauk River, with ~0.75 miles of the Sauk River flowing within the park area.

Located only 1/4 mile NW of New Munich on MN 237.



The diverse area has a variety to offer for hunters, trappers, and wildlife observers. Deer and turkey wintering areas are located within the WMA which features a variety of game species. The WMA was donated by area clubs and grants. While visiting WMAs, respect private property boundaries, and ask for permission before going onto private lands.
