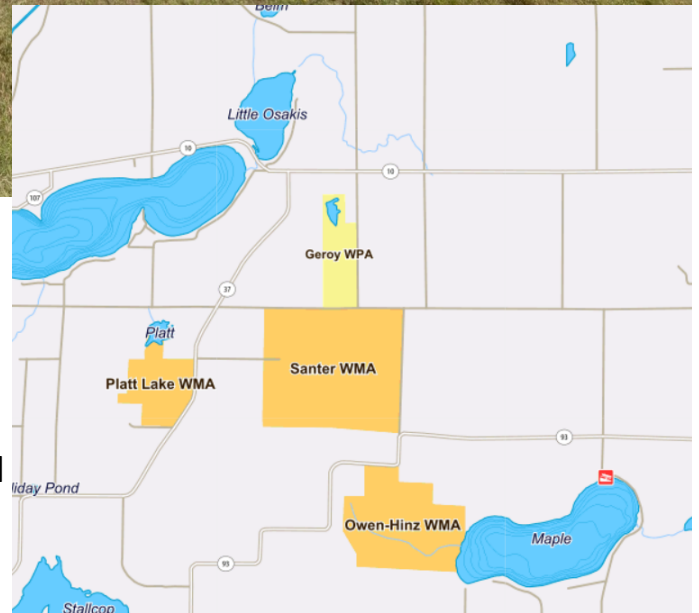
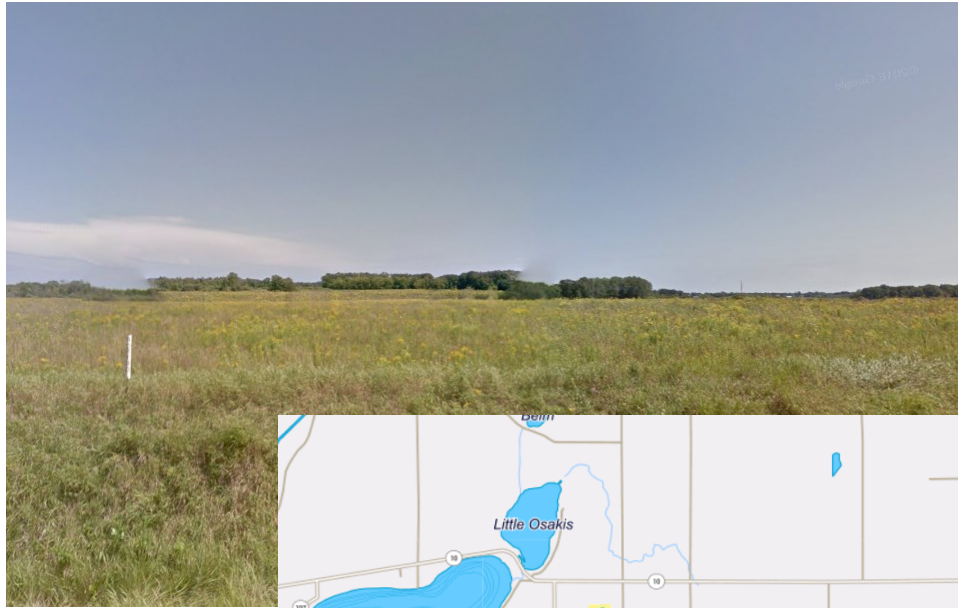


# Santer WMA

## OVERVIEW

The Santer Wildlife Management Area (WMA) sits just east of Lake Osakis off of CR 37. The 500+ acres are composed of grass fields, wetlands, cattails, low land grass, brush, crop fields, and oak-popple woods. The WMA also features restored native grass fields and restored wetlands. The management focus of this unit is to maintain and improve habitat of native plants and wildlife diversity.



The Santer WMA offers a variety of recreational opportunities year round. These include hunting, trapping, hiking, wildlife viewing, snow-shoeing, and cross-country skiing. While visiting WMAs, respect private property boundaries and ask for permission before going onto private lands. Motorized vehicles are prohibited within the WMA, except on designated parking lots and routes. \*OHVs, ATVs and snowmobiles are not allowed anywhere within the WMA, INCLUDING designated parking lots and access roads.
