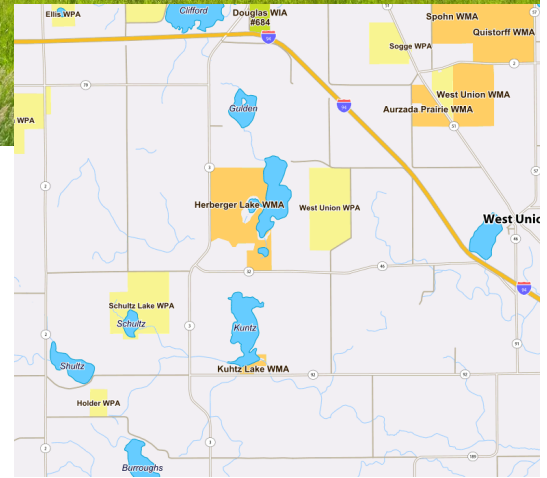


# Herberger Lake WMA

## OVERVIEW

The Herberger Lake Wildlife Management Area (WMA) sits around the **153.92 acre Herberger Lake**. Within the WMA, you can also find several wetlands and marshes. The WMA recently underwent a **wetland restoration and enhancement project** to bring the landscape back to life! The restoration was made possible by removing sediment, filling ditches, building berms and removing tile. The project was able to **restore 55 acres and 38 basins**.



The environment of Herberger Lake WMA offers a landscape for a variety of species, especially waterfowl. With the help of recent restoration the WMA offers a variety of recreational opportunities. While visiting WMAs, respect private property boundaries and ask for permission before going onto private lands.
