

Osakis WMA: North Unit

OVERVIEW

The **Osakis Wildlife Management Area (WMA) North Unit** sits between MN 27 and CSAH51 south of Osakis. The WMA features the 30-acre Stevens Lake and two additional lake/wetlands. The landscape of the Osakis WMA includes several areas of **open water with cattails**. The remaining landscape is **lowland grass or grass fields**. The management focus of this WMA is to improve and maintain habitat for diversity of native species.

The landscape of Osakis WMA offers **recreational opportunities year round**. Activities include hunting, trapping, hiking, wildlife viewing, cross-country skiing and snow shoeing. While visiting WMAs, respect private property boundaries and ask for permission before going onto private lands. No motorized vehicles are allowed on the WMA, except designated roads and parking lots. ATVs, OHVs, motorized watercraft, and snowmobiles are not allowed anywhere on the WMA.

Game Species: Deer, Small Game, Pheasants, Waterfowl

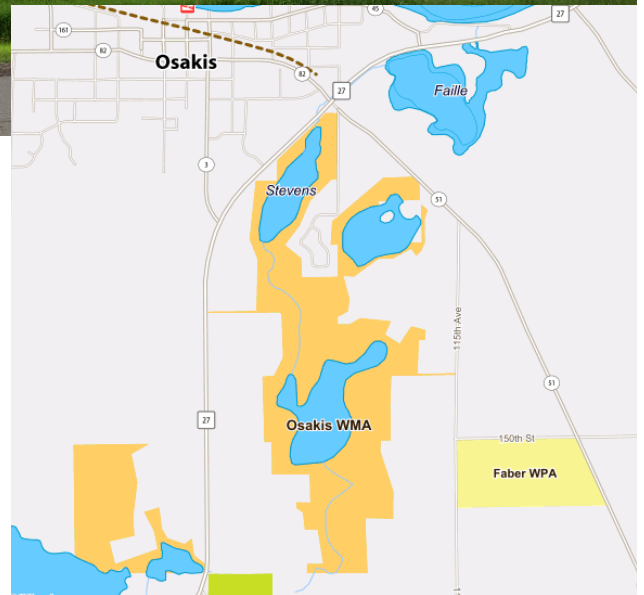
