

# Spirit Marsh WMA

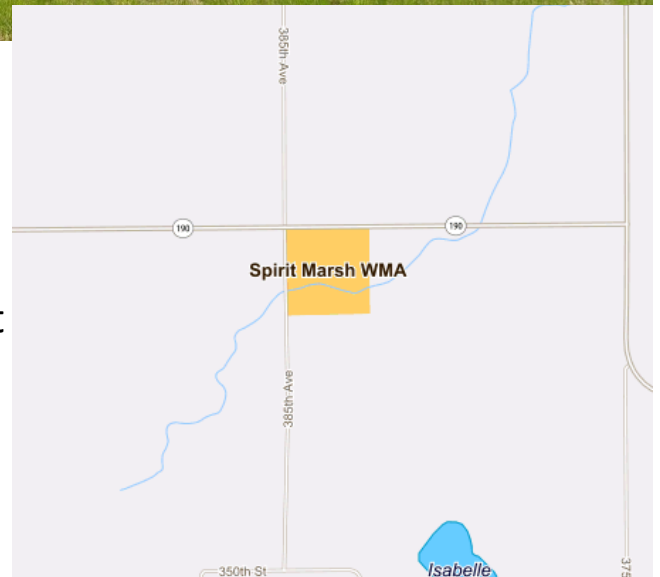
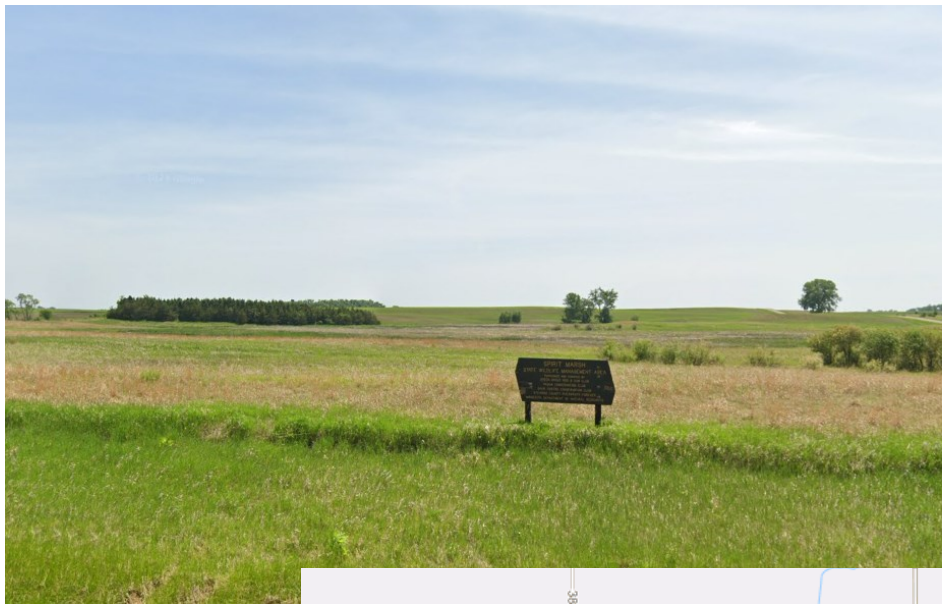
## OVERVIEW

The Spirit Marsh Wildlife Management Area (WMA) sits 6 miles southeast of Sauk Centre off of CSAH 190. The small WMA is mainly composed of a 20 acre partially drained cattail-dominant wetland. It also features prairie grassland and a 3 acre woody cover planting.

**This habitat combination results in a high diversity of wildlife.**

Spirit Marsh WMA provides the opportunity for a variety of outdoor activities. Some of the most common uses are hunting, trapping, hiking and wildlife viewing. Recreators may also notice the variety of wildflower species present and should compare this to the remnant prairie along the west roadside area when visiting.

While visiting WMAs, respect private property boundaries and ask for permission before going onto private lands.
