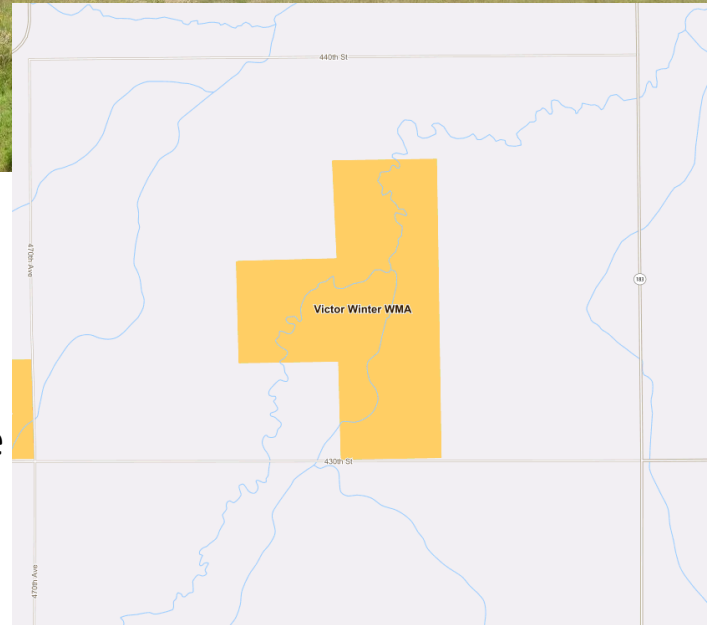


Victor Winter WMA

OVERVIEW

The Victor Winter Wildlife Management Area (WMA)

sits 5 miles west of Sauk Centre off of CSAH 193 along 430th St. The WMA neighbors Miller WMA to the west. Additionally, **Ashley Creek flows through the majority of the area.** Most of the upland area has been restored to prairie and has created excellent nesting cover.



Victor Winter WMA is part of a larger, core wintering area and is specifically It provides a variety of opportunities for outdoor activities. The most common uses are hunting, trapping, hiking and wildlife viewing. While visiting WMAs, respect private property boundaries and ask for permission before going onto private lands.
