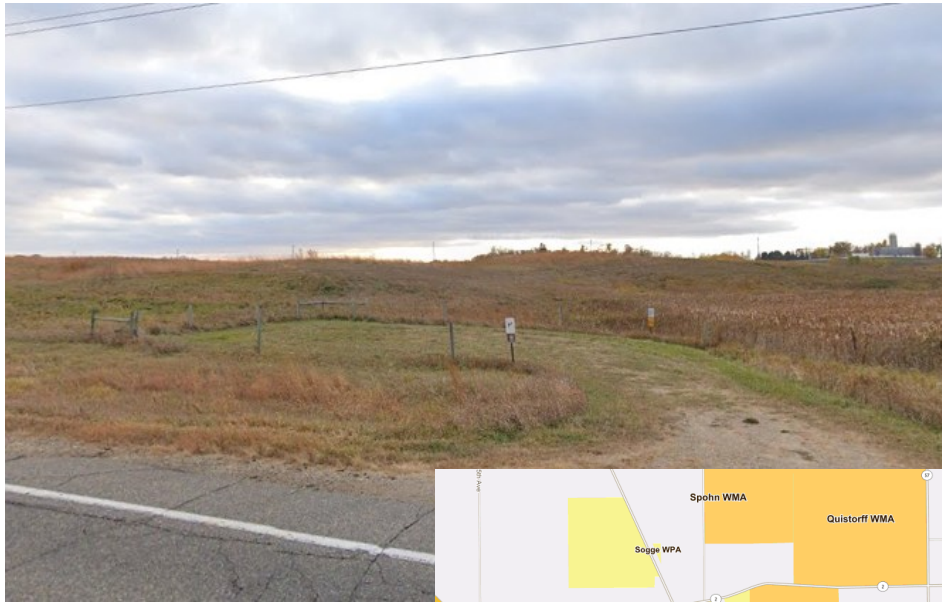


# Aurzada Prairie WMA

## OVERVIEW

### The Aurzada Prairie Wildlife Management Area (WMA)

sits 1 mile northwest of West Union. This WMA is composed of open grassland with rolling hills and restored wetlands.



This unit is part of a larger complex of 4 WMAs and 2 Federal WPAs.

Aurzada WMA provides the opportunity for a variety of outdoor activities. Some of the most common uses are hunting, trapping, hiking and wildlife viewing/photography!
