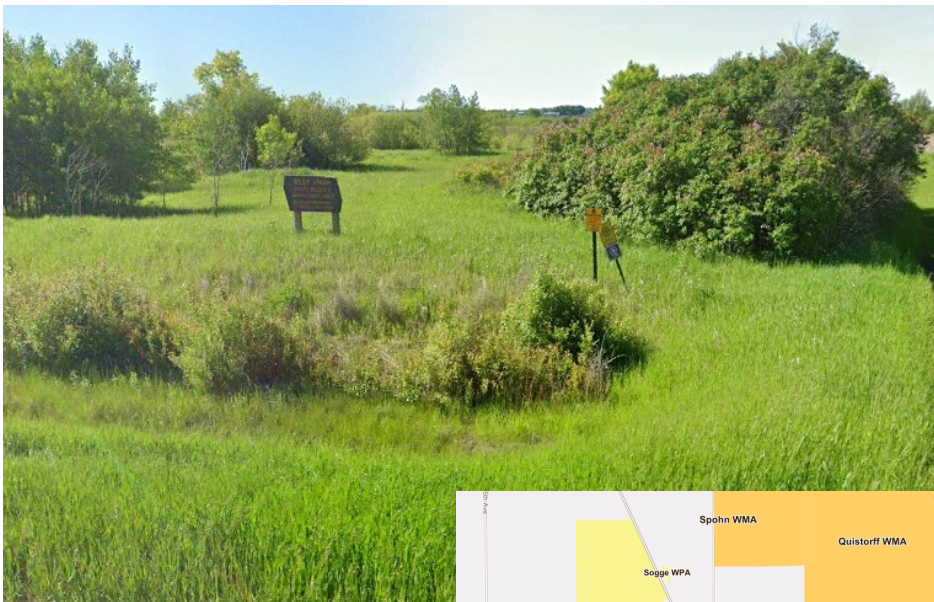


West Union WMA

OVERVIEW

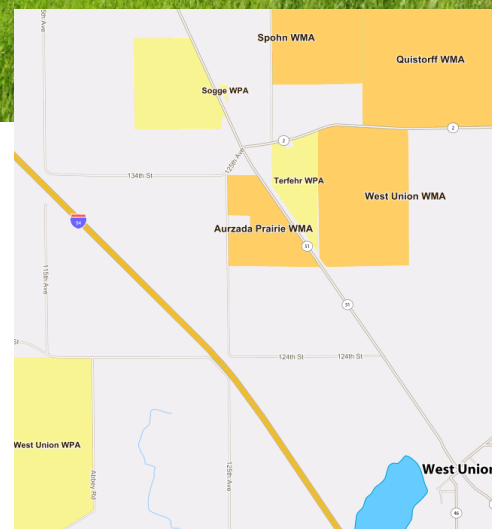
The West Union Wildlife Management Area (WMA) sits 3 miles south east of Osakis. To access this WMA from Osakis by going 2 miles south on county road 51, then 1 mile east on county road 2 southeast.



This unit is part of a larger complex of 4 WMAs and 2 Federal WPAs.

Management of this unit focuses on maintaining and improving the habitat for a diversity of native plants and wildlife. Native prairies and wetlands have been restored at this MWA.

While visiting WMAs, respect private property boundaries and ask for permission before going onto private lands.
