



Yellow Perch

General Description: One of the most commonly caught fish in Minnesota. Elongated, laterally compressed body.

Color: Golden-yellow with broad dark vertical bands .

Length: 4 - 10 inches.

Weight: Average 1 pound.

Habitat: Littoral zone of both large and small lakes.

Food: Zooplankton, insects, and smaller fish.
