



Green sunfish

General Description: Drab color and larger mouth when compared to other sunfish.

Color: Green-Blue in color with yellow flecks.

Length: 3 - 5 inches

Weight: less than a pound.

Habitat: Can tolerate greater turbidity and lower dissolved oxygen than the bluegill or pumpkinseed.

Food: zooplankton, insects, and plant matter.
