Cope's gray treefrog

General Description: Large adhesive pads on tips of fingers and toes enable them to climb vegetation.

Color: Solid green to mottled gray with bright yellow-orange coloring on inner surface of hind legs.

Length: 1 1/4 - 2 inches.

Habitat: Temporary shallow ponds, flooded fields, lake edges, ditches, grasslands and forest edges.

Food: Moths, beetles, flies, ants, and spiders.
