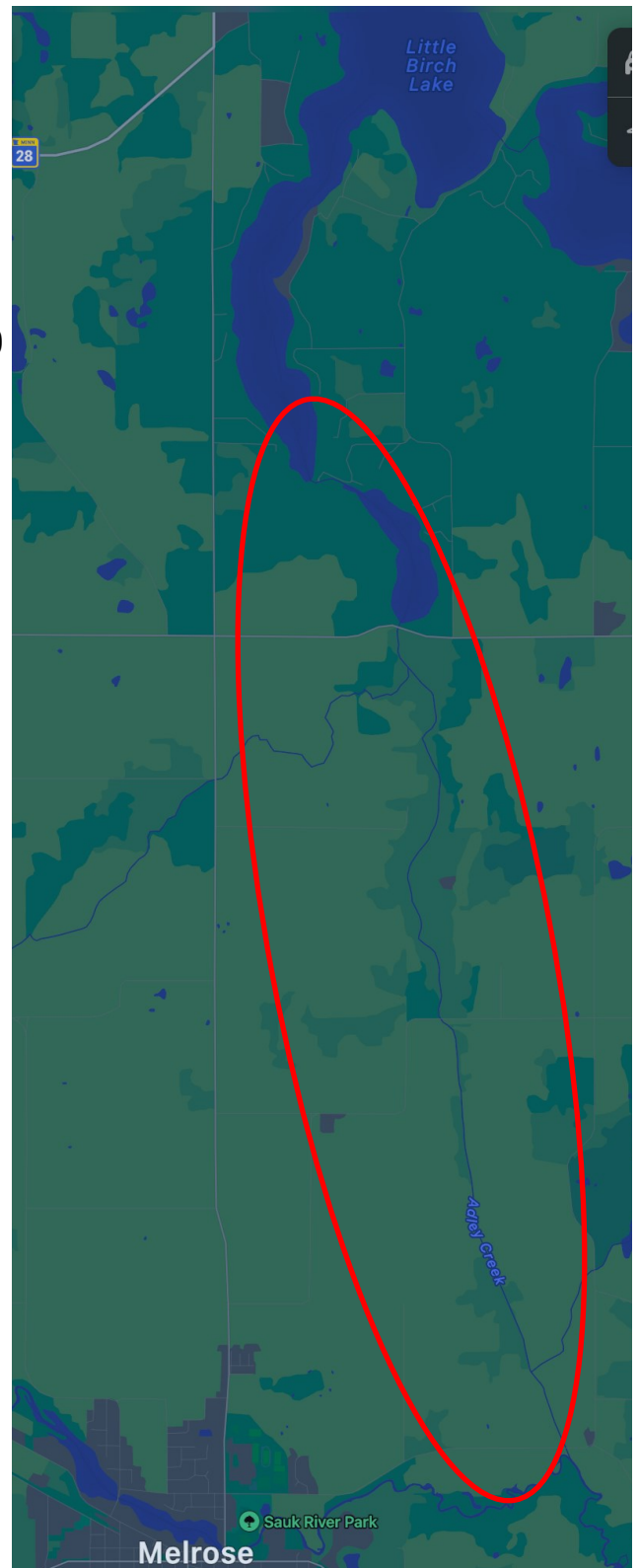


Adley Creek

OVERVIEW

Adley Creek begins at the outlet of Little Birch Lake near Grey Eagle. It only travels around 450 meters before entering into Lake Sylvia. Did you know there is a Lake Sylvia County Park by the outlet? The creek then travels south about 5 miles until it enters into the Sauk River just east of the city of Melrose.

Adley Creek has been listed as impaired for *E. coli*. There are many feedlots within its watershed, and the major source of *E. coli* to Adley is most likely nearby pastures (see TMDL report). The SRWD has monitoring data available for Adley dating back to 2003.
